Permissions and security		It is a public park, so I am able to take pictures at any time.		
		I have asked my model to sign a model release form which gives me permission to take and use pictures of them in my project.		
		I was aware that the area was open to the public and I was not trespassing when shooting		
Viewpoints, obstructions, ease of reach and safety		Floor may be damp, so I must be careful not to slip. If me or my model slipped on wet ground, there were members of the public in the area who could be able to help. There are also shops down the road who have first aid boxes. If it was a serious injury, there is also a doctor close by that would know how to treat the injury.		
Power, lighting and sound		Lighting depends on the weather conditions on the day of the shoot. I will not be using any lighting or sound equipment which means that I will only need batteries to power the camera and a spare battery pack in case that one runs out. I would also need to choose carefully the times of day that I go out to shoot as I would need the best lighting possible.		
Set dressings and props		Only a skateboard needed supplied by the model. The model would only need to wear their own clothes which they feel comfortable skateboarding. There would also be no alterations to the surrounding area as the scenery worked with the shot.		
Anticipated problems		If it rains or the floor is too wet, the shoot may be needed to be postponed.

People Other		If the batteries fail, then I would have a spare battery pack which I would be able to use to keep shooting.
